#### **COMMUNICATION FROM THE CHAIR**

**The Speaker (Hon. Nduati Kariuki):** Honourable members Pursuant to Standing Order 214 (2) (b), I wish to report that on 12<sup>th</sup> March 2019, the County Assembly received a public Petition submitted by residents of Ithanga, Gatanga Sub-County. The petitioners draw the attention of the Assembly to the matter of poor status of nearly all drifts, culvert and bridges entire Ward. I further wish to state that the Petition is signed by 25 petitioners. The petitioners confirm that the issues in respect of which the Petition are not pending before any court of law or any legal body. The petitioner's prayer is that; (a) what are the plans of the County Government of Murang'a towards improving the current status of ridges, culverts and drifts in Ithanga Ward?

Pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order 216 (1), the Petition is hereby committed to the Public Works, roads and Transport Committee. Further, pursuant to Standing Order 216 (2) the Committee shall in not more than 60 calendar days from today, respond to the petitioners by way of a Report addressed to the petitioners and laid on the Table of the Assembly.

Pursuant to Standing Order 214 (2) (b) I wish to report that on 12<sup>th</sup> March 20196, the County Assembly received a public Petition submitted by residents of Mugumo sub-location Ngilelya Sub-location, Ithanga Ward, Gatanga Sub-County. The petitioners draw the attention of the Assembly to the matter of poor status of Kasarani and Rubiru Early Childhood Development Education (ECDE) within Mugumo sub-location. I further wish to state that the Petition is signed by 14 petitioners. The petitioners confirm that the issues in respect of which the Petition are not pending before any Court of law or any legal body.

The petitioners prayer is that;

- 1. To know what the plans are of the County Government towards the current status of those two institutions and also to know the measures that have been put in place in Murang'a County Government to ensure that all kids are learning without interruptions especially during drought seasons not only in these two but all the ECDE in Ithanga Ward.
- 2. The County Government should employ two qualified teachers for each of the above two institutions.
- 3. To provide all facilities required in ECDE
- 4. Have the school gated for kids' security and also prevent outsiders from using the toilets. Pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order 216 (1), the Petition is hereby committed to the Education, Child Welfare, Research, Information Technology (IT) and E- Government Committee.

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Further, pursuant to Standing Order 216 (2) the Committee shall in not more than 60 calendar days from today, respond to the petitioners by way of a Report addressed to the petitioners and laid on the Table of the Assembly.

Pursuant to Standing Order 214 (2) (b), I wish to report that on 12<sup>th</sup> March 2019 the County Assembly received a public Petition submitted by residents of Ithanga Ward, Gatanga Sub-County. The petitioners draw the attention of the Assembly to the matter of uniform charges of licenses/levies regardless of area of operation.

I further wish to state that the Petition is signed by 32 petitioners.

The petitioners confirm that the issues in respect of which the Petition are not pending before any court of law or any legal body. The petitioners prayer is that;

- a. What are the plans of the Murang'a County Government towards improving and promoting people operating businesses in marginalized areas of Murang'a County?
- b. What are the measures that have been put in place by the County Government to ensure the business community operating in marginal areas are operating in a conducive environment?

Pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order 216 (1), the Petition is hereby committed to the Trade, Co-operative Management, Tourism and Wildlife Committee.

Further, pursuant to Standing Order 216 (2) the Committee shall in not more than 60 calendar days from today, respond to the Petitioners by way of a report addressed to the petitioners and laid on the table of the Assembly.
