**AWARE**, that own revenue is one of the revenue sources for County governments besides the equitable disbursement from National Government, further aware that Article 209 (5) of the Constitution of Kenya, grants the County Governments powers to raise revenues through imposition of taxes and charges such as property taxes, entertainment taxes and any other tax authorized by enacted legislation, cognizant of the high revenue potential especially in property rates from planned and surveyed areas which could enhance the County's sustainability, concerned that the County Government in the current and previous financial years, has been unable to meet its local revenue targets; this Assembly urges the County Executive Member in charge of Finance, I.T and Planning to effect the separation of departmental revenues, so that each department has its revenue target for effective monitoring, establish a reward system of the best performing departments in revenue collection, and in consultation with the County Public Service Board, deploy departmental revenue clerks at the sub county levels so as to boost the local revenue.
