OVERSEAS EDUCATION PARTNERSHIP PROGRAMME.

Hon John Ngugi: Hon. Speaker, I beg to give the notice for the Motion on overseas education partnership programme.

Aware that, education is a key enabler for national development and realization of Kenya's Vision 2030 and Sustainable Development Goals, Further Aware that, Article 55 of the Constitution of Kenya (2010), requires the state to take measures, including affirmative action programmes, to ensure that the youth have access to relevant education and training opportunities, to associate, be represented and participate in political, social, economic and other spheres of life, and to access productive engagement including employment and entrepreneurship, Appreciating that broadening access to education can unlock economic opportunities, increase employment rates, job security and lifetime earnings, Noting that Kenya Youth Development Policy (KYDP) 2019 seeks to provide an opportunity for improving the quality of life for the youth in Kenya through their empowerment and participation in economic and democratic processes as well as in community and civic affair, Concerned that our youth face unemployment, lack of employable skills, poor health, insufficient socio-economic support, drug use and substance abuse, involvement in crime, lack of access to basic services, limited access to ICT especially those from marginalized communities and rural areas, Informed that H.E the Governor Murang'a County led a delegation consisting of the County Executive Committee Member Finance & Economic Planning and Members of the County Assembly, to a study tour in Canada that culminated into signing Memorandum of Understanding with several Canadian Universities and Colleges, aimed at linking Murang'a youth with overseas opportunities; this Assembly

1. Directs the County Executive Committee Members in-charge of Finance and Economic Planning and Education and Technical Training, to submit the signed Memorandum of Understandings for consideration and ratification by this Assembly.

2. Urges the County Government, to explore and enter into appropriate arrangements with financial institutions, to support financially challenged students who wish to join the above initiative.

**RESOLUTION TO PETITION THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY ON COUNTY WARDS
EQUITABLE DEVELOPMENT FUND.**

Hon. Kibe Wasary: Hon. Speaker, on behalf of Hon. Jeremiah Gichobe representative of CAF I beg to give notice to the following Motion;

That, pursuant to Articles 37 and 119 of the Constitution of Kenya; this County Assembly resolves to petition the National Assembly individually and collectively as the County Assemblies Forum (CAF) vide the annexed draft Petition for the National Assembly to intervene and ensure;

1. That, the County Wards Development Fund be incorporated in the proposed constitutional amendment Bill before the National Assembly by Hon. Stephen Mule, M.P. and Hon. Gichimu Githinji , M.P. alongside other proposed funds namely the National Government Constituency Development Fund (NGCDF), the National Government Affirmative Action Fund (NGAAF) the Senate Oversight Fund and the Economic Stimulus and Empowerment Fund either prior to the public action of the said Bill or before it is referred to the Senate in accordance with rules of procedure of parliament.
2. That, the proposed constitutional amendment Bill in amending Article 203 of the Constitution should provide the following with respect to county wards equitable development fund;
 - i. That each County Government shall allocate funds comprising of a certain percentage of the respective total county's annual budget estimates or as shall be advised by the Commission on Revenue Allocation (CRA) during the enactment of the County Allocation of revenue Act to cater for the County Wards Equitable Development Fund.
 - ii. That all monies allocated to the county wards equitable development fund shall be considered as funds allocated to wards pursuant to Article 206 (2)

(c), to be administered in accordance with provisions of an Act of parliament;
and

- iii. That the parliament shall enact a legislation to provide for the administrative of the county wards equitable development funds.
