Background

1. In an Assembly plenary sitting held on November 10, 2015, Hon. Danson Mburu Muchoki requested for a Statement from Chairperson, Public Works, Roads and Transport committee. The Chairperson requested for 14 days to prepare for a response that was to be obtained from the County Executive Member for Energy, Transport and Infrastructure.

Problem Statement

2. The Statement requested by Hon. Danson Mburu Muchoki was as follows;

Pursuant to Standing Order 175, and 45 (2) (c), Section 17 of the County Government Act, 2012 and Article 195 of the constitution, **Hon. Danson Mburu Muchoki , MCA Makuyu Ward**, in a sitting held on November 10, 2015, requested for a Statement from the Chairperson Public Works, Roads and Transport Committee;

- i) Is the Chairperson aware that Mithini-Mutithi bridge is completely damaged thus hindering access to Mithini polytechnic?
- ii) Is he also aware that Mithini-Kinoo bridge is also in a dilapidated condition thus hindering vehicles from accessing Kinoo Primary School?
- iii) Is the Chairperson further aware that Kiyoo Nama-Mugumoini road is in a deplorable condition thus rendering it impassable by vehicles?
- iv) Can the Chairperson inform the Assembly on when the aforesaid road and two bridges will be repaired?

Methodology

3. The Committee resolved to forward the Statement requested in the Assembly to the County Executive Member for Transport and Infrastructure development. This was in order for him to investigate on the matter and issue a response thereafter.

Response

4. The Committee received the response from the County Executive Member for Transport and Infrastructure Development on April 27, 2016 after reminding him to issue the same. The following was the response as per the questions posed;

- i) Is the Chairperson aware that Mithini-Mutithi bridge is completely damaged thus hindering access to Mithini polytechnic?

The said bridge is not completely damaged as stated. The current status is that the structure's surface has potholes.

- ii) Is he also aware that Mithini-Kinoo bridge is also in a dilapidated condition thus hindering vehicles from accessing Kinoo Primary School?

Yes the Chairperson is aware.

- iii) Is the Chairperson further aware that Kiyo Nama-Mugumoini road is in a deplorable condition thus rendering it impassable by vehicles?

Yes the Chairperson is aware.

- iv) Can the Chairperson inform the Assembly on when the aforesaid road and two bridges will be repaired?

The County Executive Member has requested for an imprest from the department of Finance and Economics planning so as to initiate repair Mithiini-Muthithi and Mithiini- Kinoo bridges.





