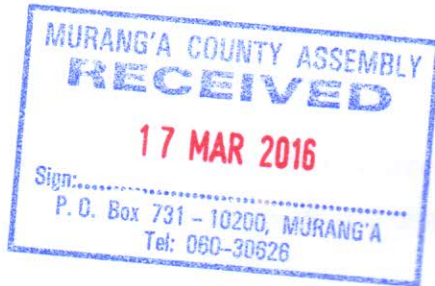

HEALTH IS WEALTH

Health is major pillar in socio-economic development for all Nations. The Constitution of Kenya 2010 assigned majority of health care service delivery to the Counties in Article 43 (1) (a) in particular;

- i. Health facilities and pharmacies
- ii. Ambulance services
- iii. Primary health care
- iv. Licensing and control of undertaking that sell food to the public
- v. Cemeteries, funeral parlours and crematoria
- vi. Refuse removal and disposal

It is the mandate of Murang'a County Government to hence ensure the above functions enshrined in health standards of its populace is met. This mandate is pegged to the Department of Health and Sanitation and it serves as its core agenda in its goal, vision and mission.

Attaining the highest possible standard of health in a manner responsive to the needs of the population of Murang'a

Vision

An efficient health care delivery system that will provide affordable, holistic and quality services in Murang'a County.

Mission

Establish a highly motivated, equipped and appropriately resourced workforce capable of providing high quality preventive, promotive, curative and rehabilitative health care services which are accessible, affordable and efficient to Murang'a residents.

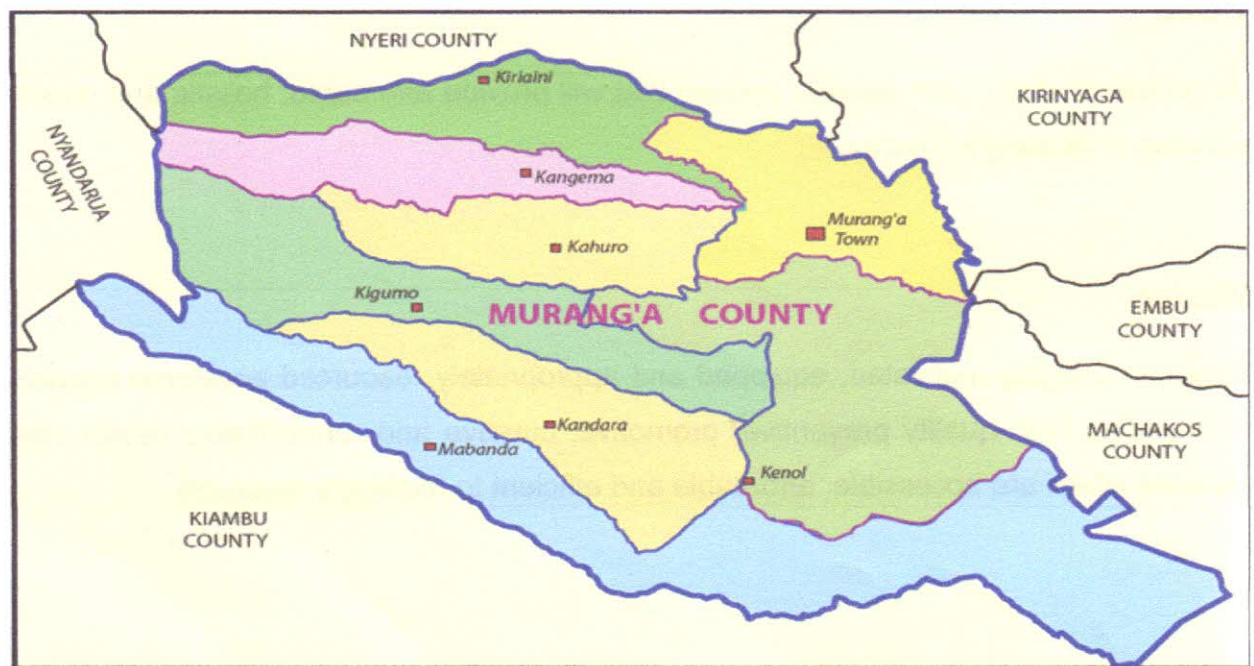
Objectives

BACKGROUND INFORMATION OF THE COUNTY

Murang'a County is one of the five Counties in the central region with a total population of 1,004,833 (projected from the 2009 census with a growth rate of 1.6%). It covers an area of 2,325 sqkm. There are 7 sub-counties namely; Kiharu, Mathioya, Kangema, Maragua, Kigumo, Kandara and Gatanga. Kiharu is the constituency with the highest population rate. The adult's population (25-59 years) constitutes the largest proportion of the population.

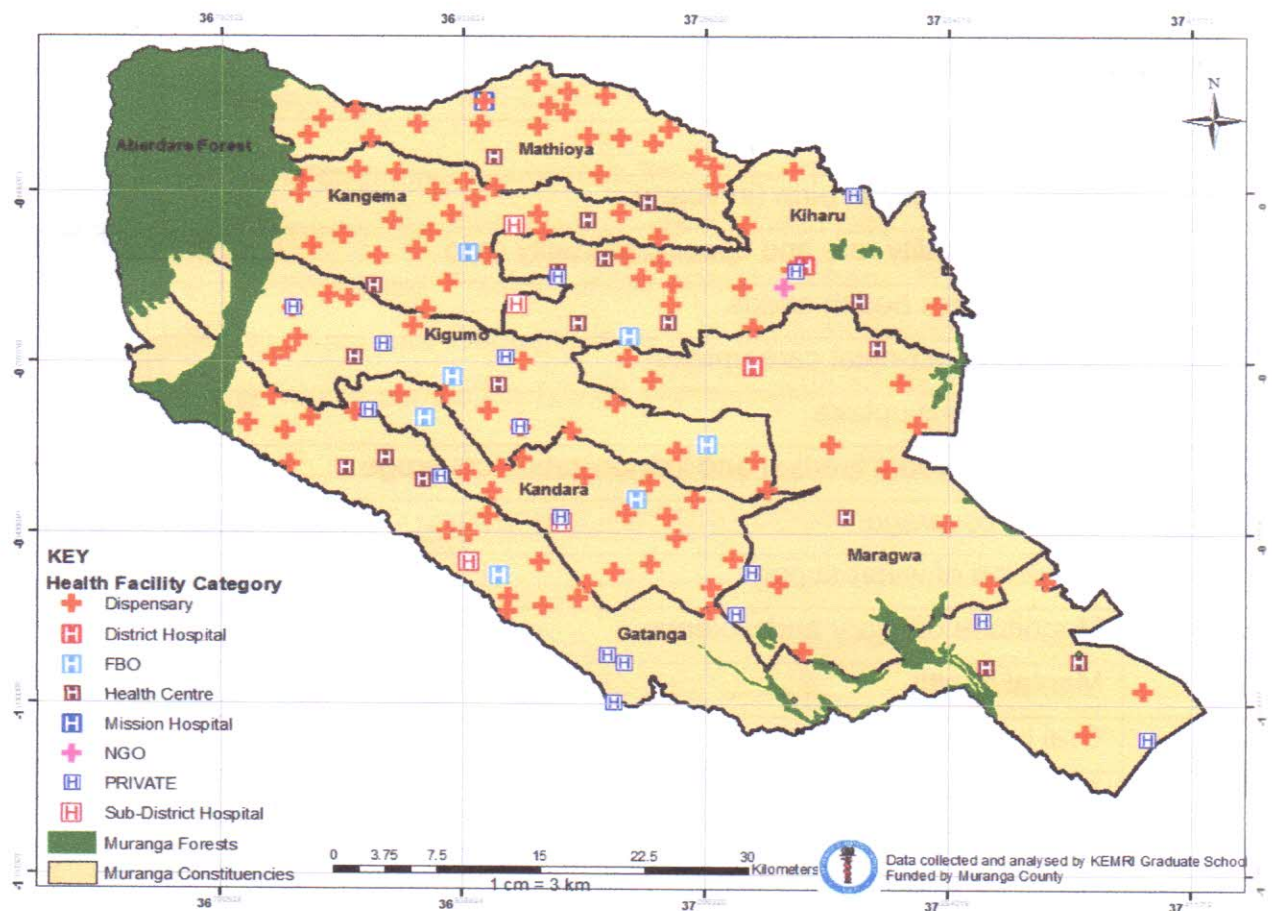

Health care facilities

The County has 7 hospitals, 26 health centres and 106 dispensaries (see the map below). The hospitals include; Murang'a, Kangema, Muriranjas, Maragua. Others include; Kandara, Kigumo and Kirwarwa which were upgraded in the fiscal year 2015/2016.

PROGRESS AND CURRENT STATUS OF MURANG'A COUNTY HEALTH CARE

1.1 Community Health Volunteer Program

The program on health workers program was launched on 7th December 2015. CEC responsible for health presided over the ceremony for over 700 volunteers (20 from each ward). This brought to a total of 1,653 active CHVs. Among this 124 are Supported by Kenya Red Cross, 29 by Population Services Kenya (PSk) and 700 by the County government. The remaining are enlisted by the County government for support when the budget allows.

During the launch, all the 700 CHVs were issued with uniforms (jackets, capes, badges) for identification during their routine volunteer work and a bag for carrying the medical kitty.

A contingency plan was drawn for all the rehabilitated alcoholics' socio-economic improvement. These include;

- Employment/re-absorption to the workforce for the professionals
- Re-tooling those with specific life skills for manual works

- Technical courses at vocational training centres
- Cow ownership for daily farming

Below is the progress

- A total of 24 have been employed as casual laborers through the County Public Service Board (see attached annex 1)
- A total of 5 taken back to school (see annex 2)
- A total of 255 persons have been registered at vocational training centers (see the attached annex 3)
- A total of 12 with specific life skills have been issued with tools of trade and are now working. See the attached list of tools (Annex 4)
- About 55 are in the process of being issued with daily cows through the cow ownership program that works under the Murang'a County Creameries.
- Further to this, 419 persons were issued with ID cards and 607 issued with NHIF cards.

A follow-up program is in place for every sub-County for close monitoring and to prevent the transformed having a relapse. This is done through a sub-committee that comprises of the chairman, patron and 2 counselors in each ward. However, there has been challenges of transport that is affecting their optimal operation.

The County liquor enforcement team ("kaa sober") has been formulated for purposes of enforcing Murang'a County Alcoholic Drinks Control Act 2014. The team comprises of County Enforcement Officer, Kenya Police Service personnel and the community members. The Chief Officer of Health is the chair person.

Licensing of bars for 2016 is ongoing. So far applications have been done and inspection of premises is ongoing. Later a public participation will be conducted in each sub-county before issuance of licenses. The process will be complete by end of March 2016.

1.3 Muranga County health bill

Chapter IV of the constitution of Kenya requires the County government to promote realization of health rights. This is not possible with the current bureaucracies in place at the County level. A health bill is therefore crucial to provide a legal framework for the management of health facilities and funds.

Currently, Murang'a County Health Bill draft was prepared by all health departmental heads with the leadership of CEC and CEO health and is undergoing legal scrutiny for purposes of legal backing. The process is required to be complete by end this month and forwarded to assembly for discussion.

1.4 Human Resource

1.4.1 Economic Stimulus Program (ESP) workers

An outstanding court case between Murang'a Public Service Commission vs ESP health workers was finalized in December 2015. The ruling was favorable to the 177 workers whereas they were required to be reinstated in Permanent and Pensionable from the date their contract expired. This has so far happened and the officers were paid their January salaries as per the terms. The finance department is preparing to pay the arrears accrued.

Note: the 87 health workers who had been hired during the strike were also absorbed.

1.4.2

About 217 health workers from different cadres have been promoted in different job groups as per their qualifications and other requirements.

1.4.3 County health management boards and committees

Elections were carried out in all the health facilities within Murang'a County that saw the formation of Health Management Boards and Committees. These boards and committees were established in Kenya in 1992 by Legal Notice No.162 of the Public Health Act (Cap. 242).

Their role is to:

- i. Represent the community interest in the health planning process;
- ii. Review, approve and forward cost sharing AIE requests and estimates of recurrent and development budgets.
- iii. Work with health personnel to coordinate and monitor the implementation of GoK and non-GoK health programmes;
- iv. Identify implementation problems and seek corrective action;
- v. Advocate for cost sharing and promote health awareness among the general public

Currently, the gazettment process is ongoing

1.4.4 Casuals

The department has a total of 588 casuals within the County who are paid in the County government payroll system. The department receives requests from the health facilities, prepare the payroll and forward the same to the County Director of Human Resource. The payment is done at the end of every month. Occasionally, there are delays in the process, but currently no arrears.

1.5 Donor projects initiated by the Health Department

1.5.1 Maragua hospital (By Vidha Association)

- Opening up of lung and skin clinic. This included; renovation of the skin clinic, training of 28 health care workers on diagnosis and management of common skin conditions and 2 years employment of a clinical officer and a health records officer.

Note: The officers need to be adopted by the County government by the end of two years.

- Installation of wifi in selected areas of the hospital
- Construction of two portable water fountains
- Renovation of the Nursing officer's in charges office

1.5.2 Kandara health centre

An x-ray machine and its processor worth Ksh 11,000,000 has been donated to Kandara health centre by Africa Digna through Vidha association.

The County government was required to construct a room where the machines would be housed. So far this has been awarded and the contractor is almost completing the works.

The donor is looking forward to launching the unit on 22nd June, 2016 and training of radiographers. By that time the construction of the room and powering it will be complete.

1.5.3 Kamung'ang'a, Kandara, Wanjengi and Kigumo health facilities

Construction and/or refurbishment of these facilities is being carried out by DANIDA.

Note: All the work in the above facilities is more than 50% complete.

1.5.4 Clinton Health Access initiative (CHAI)

The objective of this health partner was to support commodity management. This involved provision of both hardware and software to health facilities pharmacies that will assist the pharmacy personnel to generate drugs orders (automatic quantification), show the expiry dates as well as stock outs. So far with the support of the County health staff, the team has managed to assess all the health facilities for support. Out of those assessed, 72 facilities met their criteria for support.

So far all the facilities have been issued with computers as well as the software programs and trained one pharmacy technologist in each sub-county.

1.5.5 Population Services Kenya (PSk), Kenya Red Cross and Division of non-communicable diseases

PSk Support 29 community health volunteers. They have so far trained them on how to check blood pressure and have issued each with a blood pressure machine. Each of this CHV is given a stipend of Ksh 2,000 every month.

Kenya Red cross support 124 CHVs and have continued to train them on various health promotion programs. Each of this CHV is given a stipend of Ksh 2,000 every month.

The division of non-communicable diseases have trained 30 CHVs on Diabetes management and 7 community units on integrated community case management for the under-fives. It has in addition given out 4 glucometers

1.6 National government projects

1.6.1 Murang'a Referral hospital

The National government embarked on Managed Equipment Services (MES) project that saw Murang'a County referral hospital having the following works done;

- Refurbishment of the theatre unit and equipping it
- Renovation and re-organization of the Central Sterilizing Unit (CSU)
- Construction of a unit that houses the Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) machine and equipping it
- Refurbishment of the x-ray unit that also houses digital mammogram and ultra sound equipment
- Training of staff (2 medical engineers and one Consultant Doctor trained on MRI, 2 on X-ray and one on theatre machines operations. The trainings were conducted in China. Other staff (1 nurse and 2 casuals) were also trained for the central sterilizing unit in Thika.

Note: A replica of the x-ray unit, central sterilizing unit and theatre renovations and equipping will be done in Maragua hospital

1.6.1 MRI machine

Nb: The machine is able to make pictures of organs and structures that are inside the body for any abnormalities

1.6.2 Maragua hospital

An incinerator worth Ksh 12,000,000 was donated and in place. The County government was required to construct its housing. So far, the process of awarding to a pre-qualified contractor has been completed and the contractor is required to start the work within 30 days.

1.7 The County Government

1.7.1 Laundry machines

Laundry machine have been purchased for Murang'a Referral hospital (55kgs), Kandara and Kirwara Sub-County hospitals 25kgs and 23kgs respectively and 13kgs for Kenneth Matiba hospital.

1.7.2 Generator

A generator (300KVA) has been purchased for Murang'a referral hospital as a backup power system

1.7.3 Purchase of laboratory diagnostic equipment

A number of diagnostic equipment have been bought that have allowed many samples to be examined. The photo below is one of such equipment.

1.7.4 Renal unit

Dialysis is ongoing for the patients with renal failures. Currently the unit is able to dialyze 24 patients in a week. This is the optimal number that the unit can handle. Other patients (61) are in the waiting list. More dialysis machines and an extension of the unit is urgently required to meet the demand of most patients.

Each patient undergoing dialysis pays Ksh. 2,000 if he/she is an NHIF member (the card pays Ksh.2, 500). This is lower than what other hospitals giving out the same services are charging.

For non NHIF members, the charges are Ksh. 4,500

1.7.5 Construction of wards and administration block for Kirwara hospital

Kirwara hospital urgently required wards and administration block to be able to effectively carry out health services. The County government embarked on a mission to construct one storey block that would hold the services. The block is estimated at a cost of Kshs 63,500,000 and scheduled to take 24 months.

So far, 2 floors have been done. The challenge has been to fund the project.

1.7.6 Kenneth Matiba eye and Dental care hospital

- All the major equipment required for the eye and dental clinic are in place.
- Four dental chairs, consumables, autoclave and other machines for making dentures have been purchased. Six more dental chairs have been ordered.
- The branding of the hospital is complete.
- Staff and casuals have been deployed
- The wards are ready for occupancy

The hospital is already in operation for the Dental and eye services. However, the administration block as well as cancer diagnostic unit is not yet complete, but the contractor is on the ground. The services will be offered later.

1.7.7 National Health Insurance Fund Scheme (NHIF)

NHIF scheme has been enhanced to cater for more clients as follows.

- 18,000 persons (the elderly who are above 65 years, those living with disabilities and the orphans) sponsored by the World Bank. Currently the recruitment is on-going. The caretaker will by default be the card NHIF holder. The cover will be comprehensive in class A & B category hospitals.
- Community health volunteers and the rehabilitated alcoholics sponsored by the County government

Note: NHIF need to be introduced to all Murang'a residents to reduce the burden of health care in our hospitals. The more people are registered with NHIF, the more is the capitation in the particular hospital which they are registered. This money in return can be used to improve the infrastructural status of the health facilities. Furthermore the waivers requested by numerous patients and affect tremendously the revenue collected in the hospital will be a thing of the past.

Nb: More than 150 requests in 2015/16 financial year were received at County Headquarters health office and more than Ksh 5,000,000 used to pay for hospital bills. This excludes waivers done at the hospital level.

NHIF more conducted activities

- Social mobilization to enhance awareness in various sub-Counties. The process is still on-going. Many people have been able to get recruited.
- Today, the Public health facilities have turned to be the best choice of facility due to availability of drugs at selected chemist whenever the drugs are missing at the Public hospitals.

1.7.8 Health promotion activities

1.7.8.1 Public health activities (see annex 6)

1.7.8.2 HIV main activities

- Drafting of Murang'a County AIDS strategic plan is ongoing. So far the draft is in the final review at the National Aids Control Council (NACC)
- Identification and improvement of the National HIV training curriculum that continues being used in Kijabe hospital
- Development of strategies to improve HIV testing & Counseling
- Community Home Based Care with support of CHVs
- Electronic medical report (EMR) upgrading in 12 HIV sites through the assistance of I-Tech health partners

1.7.8.3 Polio campaigns

Polio campaigns were carried out in the month of December. A coverage of 104% was achieved. This activity was sponsored by the National government

1.7.8.4 Adolescent's health promotion

A number of activities were carried out that included;

- Health education of the young people in school health programs more so on drugs and HIV

- Circumcision of 2,039 boys at various 8 sites and follow-up for 2 weeks on their healing and psycho-social therapy.

This was funded by the County government after health department realizing and highlighting the problem of old boys (20 years and above) not having been circumcised due to lack of medical fee charged for this process. A number of mentally retarded persons were also circumcised.

Note: About 200 boys circumcised were over 20 years.

1.7.8.5 Capacity building

Various trainings, seminars and workshops were conducted throughout the year (see annex 7)

1.7.8 Challenges

- Inadequate funding for infrastructure development
- Shortages of human resources and more so the specialists in all cadres
- Low staff motivation occasioned by multiple factors
- Erratic and delayed supply of medical commodity and supplies

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
