**6\* NOTICE OF MOTION - FORMULATION OF A POLICY ON SPECIAL PROGRAMMES**

*(Hon. Lilian Kabaya, Member of County Assembly)*

**AWARE**, that every person has the right to accessible and adequate housing, right to be free from hunger, and to have adequate food of acceptable quality, right to social security and right to the highest attainable standard of health, pursuant to Article 43, of the Constitution of Kenya 2010, further aware that the Constitution provides that the state shall provide appropriate social security to persons who are unable to support themselves and their dependants, cognisant of the fact that Health Services is a devolved County function under part 2 of the Fourth schedule, informed that provision of good health and wellbeing is one of the sustainable development goals (SDGS), alive to the fact that attaining the highest possible health standards in a manner responsive to the population needs is the core focus of the Kenya Health Sector Strategic plan, under Vision 2030, and the National Government manifesto, realising that there is need for protection of the economically and socially vulnerable persons in the County including the elderly, widows, orphans, the homeless, persons living with disability, and persons with mental illness; this House urges the County Executive Committee Members in-charge of Special Programmes and Health to

1. Formulate a policy outlining how the County Government of Murang'a will provide basic needs to cover persons who are poor, vulnerable, disabled and mentally ill
2. Develop a special programme to provide support to vulnerable persons in Murang'a including the poor, vulnerable, disabled and mentally ill.
3. Establish a registration system for registration of vulnerable persons in the County.
