8* MOTION - <u>DEVELOPMENT OF AN AFFIRMATIVE ACTION POLICY</u> ON ROADS DEVELOPMENT

AWARE that, Article 20 (5) (b) of the Constitution provides that in allocating resources, the State shall give priority to ensuring the widest possible enjoyment of the right or fundamental freedom having regard to prevailing circumstances, including the vulnerability of particular groups or individuals, further aware that Article 204 (2) of the Constitution establishes an Equalization Fund to provide basic services including water, roads, health facilities and electricity to marginalized areas, cognizant of the fact that Section 102 (g) of the County Governments Act, 2012 underscores equity in resource allocation within the County, appreciating that Ithanga, Kakuzi, Makuyu and Kambiti Wards are vast and fall within the parameters of marginalized regions, whose infrastructural development lags behind; this House resolves that the County Executive Member in charge of Energy, Transport and Infrastructure,

- i. Develops an affirmative action policy on roads development for Ithanga, Kakuzi and Makuyu and Kambiti Wards and submits it to the County Assembly before the Budget for FY 2019/2020 is approved, to ensure parity in infrastructural development;
- ii. Ensures that with effect from FY 2019/2020 Budget, the said Wards are allocated more grading hours, more kilometers of gravel and more culverts as compared to other Wards to reduce regional disparities in infrastructural development as enshrined in the Constitution.
