11* MOTION - INCREASE OF BUDGETARY ALLOCATION FOR ECDES

(Hon. Edwin Wairagu, MCA Gitugi Ward)

AWARE THAT, pre-primary education is a devolved function as per the Second Schedule of the Constitution of Kenya 2010, noting that high quality childhood education and care gives children the best start in life, further noting that Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) no.4 advocates for quality education for all people across the globe, acknowledging the infrastructural developments done in County ECDE Centers by the County government during the FY 2023-2024, regretting that most ECDE Centers even though well-constructed lack proper learning materials and do not have adequate personnel to enable progressive learning;

CONCERNED THAT success in Early Childhood Development can only be achieved through integration of both infrastructural and technical support; **this Assembly** urges the County Executive Committee Member for Education and Technical Training to allocate at least **Kshs. 100 million** under ECDE development to specifically cater for procurement of learning materials and employment of teachers during the FY 2024-25. The program should be included in the Annual Development Plan (ADP) 2024-25 and consequently appear as a priority in the County Fiscal Strategy Paper (CFSP) 2024 and the Budget Estimates FY 2024-25.
