AWARE, that Article 43 (d) of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 states that every person has a right to a clean and safe water in adequate quantities which includes the right to have water in adequate amounts for basic needs, further aware that Part 2 (11) of the Forth Schedule of the Constitution of Kenya 2010, recognizes the role of the County in Water and Sanitation Services, cognizant of the fact many waters users within the County in the upper regions have unfair advantage of excessive and uncontrolled usage of the scarce water resources denying many households in Murang'a County who live downstream go without water; this Assembly urges the CEC in-charge of Environment and Natural Resource to formulate a policy on protection and control of the water usage upstream by encouraging the County Water providers to install water meters in all homes in the County to ensure adequate water supply for basic needs of the residents downstream.
