- a) Have the health workers absorbed in permanent and pensionable terms
- b) Have all; the pending allowances for those staff paid immediately
- c) Harmonize health Worker salaries as per their respective scales of the workers on permanent and pensionable terms

However, on February 3rd 2015, the committee invited the petitioners for hearing and established that the matter was *sub judice* hence could not be deliberated upon since the interim orders of Injunction had been issued by the employment and labor relations court of Kenya at Nairobi, petition number 12 of 2015, So Honorable members that is the communication I had to make in relation to that petition."
