- b) To establish a forensic laboratory for gathering and storage of DNA samples after reported rape cases
- c) To establish proper coordination and collaboration among law enforcers, hospitals and community through all inclusive sensitization, prevention and management of post rape care.
- d) Abolish fees charged to the victims for services rendered.
- e) To put in place mechanisms on engagement with National Government for establishment of specialized sexual offences unit within the investigating Police Stations in the County.
