THE Murang'a county assembly has rejected a report recommending compensation to victims of land irregularities caused by the now-defunct county council.

The report was tabled by the Committee of Lands, Housing, Physical Planning and Settlement chairman Duncan Njuguna on disputed ownership of Rurii Secondary School land.

It recommended compensation to Ruth Kereka, who was embroiled in a land dispute with the previous county council.
