AWARE that Article 43 (d)of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 stipulates that every person has the right to clean and safe water in adequate quantities, cognizant of the fact that a good number of households in Murang'a County lack piped water supply; **this House** urges the County Executive Committee Member in charge of Public Works, Roads and Transport to;

- 1) Enlarge water intakes and main delivery pipes respectively in the County.
- 2) Construct new water intakes to increase the resource in order to meet the demand by the increasing population

Pursuant to Standing Order 45 (2) (c), I hereby request for a statement from the Chairperson Water, Energy, Forestry, Environment Natural Resources and Cooperative Committee on the following;

- i) Is the Chairperson aware of the existence of Karii Waste Disposal Site in Mbiri Ward?
- ii) If the answer to the above is affirmative, is he aware that the facility fails to comply with Environmental Management and Coordination (Waste Management) Regulations Legal Notice No. 121 of 2006?
- iii) Is the Chairperson aware that the road to the dumpsite namely Muthigiriri is in deplorable condition thus contributing to littering of the road by the trucks transporting the waste to the facility?
- iv) Can the Chairperson table a report on the compliance of the Waste Disposal Site with the said Legal Notice.
