6* NOTICE OF MOTION – (Hon Mary Waithira Njoroge – MCA Nominated)

AWARE that staff from the defunct Local Authorities were seconded to the County Government by the Transition Authority and that the Transition term of three years is ending in August 2015, further aware that Section 59 (1) (b) of the County Government Act No. 17 of 2012, mandates the County Public Service Board to appoint persons to hold or act in offices of the County Public Services including in the boards of cities and urban areas and confirm appointments, Cognisant of the fact that the Murang'a County Government has not carried out this function as stipulated in the County Government Act, which is causing anxiety and suffering among the affected staff; **this House** urges the County Public Service Board to interview, confirm and appoint all the interim staffs within the next ninety days.

Pursuant to Standing Order 45 (2) (c), I hereby request for a statement from the Chairperson of Health Services on the following;

- 1) Is the Chairperson aware that in the FY 2014/2015, the Assembly approved a budget of Kshs 5 Million for the building and equipping of a maternity wing at Iruri Dispensary?.
- 2) Is he also aware that in the FY 2014/2015 the Assembly approved a budget of Kshs 5 million for the extension and rehabilitation of Maragua District Hospital Mortuary.
- 3) As we are coming towards the end of this financial year, when will these two projects be implemented?
