6* NOTICE OF MOTION - (Chairperson, Committee on Delegated County Legislation)

THAT, this Assembly adopts the report of the joint Committee on Delegated County Legislation, Trade, Industrialization, Tourism and Wildlife and Health Services, on ammendments of Muranga County Alcoholic Drinks Control Act 2014, laid on the Table of the Assembly, on September 15, 2015.

8* MOTION - (Chairperson, Health Services Committee)

THAT, this Assembly adopts the Report of the Health Services Committee, on the Cholera out break in Murang'a County, laid on the Table of the Assembly on Tuesday September 15, 2015.

9* MOTION – (Chairperson, Water, Energy, Forestry, Environment, Natural Resources and Cooperatives Committee)

AWARE that Article 43 of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 guarantees every person the right to clean and safe water in adequate quantities, as well as accessible and reasonable standards of sanitation, further aware that it is the obligation of the County Government to prevent third parties from interfering in any way with the enjoyment of the right to water through stringent legislations,

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harsh tariffs enforcement or unfair regulatory systems, cognizant of the fact that the Water Services Providers in Murang'a previously owned by the defunct Local Authorities are now under County Government of Murang'a, further aware that water and sanitation services are a devolved function under section 11 (b) Part 2 of the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010, concerned that there is a public outcry over the outrageous increase in water tariffs by the Murang'a Water and Sanitation Company vide **Gazzette Notice No. 3462** dated **May 23,2014**, **Vol CXI No.65** alarmed that there was no adequate public participation carried out before the increased rates were imposed, deeply concerned that gazzettement of the new water tariffs did not follow due process; this **House RESOLVES** to suspend the implementation of the legal Gazzette Notice **No. 3462** of **2014**, **VOL CXI No.65**, with immediate effect until the petition submitted by members of the public on the proposed water tariffs is heard and determined.
