It is notified that, pursuant to Standing Order 45 (2) (c), the Speaker has approved the following request for statements on Thursday May 5, 2016.

7* STATEMENTS – (Hon. Joseph Njoroge Mwangi, MCA Mbiri Ward).

Pursuant to Standing Order 45 (2)(c), I hereby request for a statement from the Chairperson Public Works, Roads and Transport Committee as follows;

- i) Is the Chairperson aware that the road to Kayuyu dispensary in Gikindu Location, Mbiri Ward is not accessible especially during the rainy season due to its deplorable condition?
- ii) When will the road to the dispensary and other institutions such as Chief's camp and Kayuyu Primary be rehabilitated so as to enhance accessibility to the said institutions?
