6* NOTICE OF MOTION - HON. CAROLINE NJOROGE

AWARE, that roads function is a shared responsibility between the National and County government, according to fourth schedule and part II Constitution of Kenya, 2010, Further aware, that the County Governments are responsible for classes D, E and unclassified roads, Noting that majority of County roads in Murang'a County are in dire need of development, rehabilitation and maintenance, notwithstanding recent significant budgetary outlay for the program by the Murang'a County Government, Concerned on the need to not only improve road network in the County, but as well as furtherance of objects of devolution of protecting and promoting the interests and rights of minorities pursuant to Article 174 (e) of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010, Further noting that, in the County there exists a number of village polytechnics that can harnessed as centers of locally applied technology in road construction applicable to the County roads, Desirous of the need to implement the presidential directive on the 30% youth Access to

Government Procurement Opportunities (YAGPO) program to the local youth in Murang'a County, this House urges the County Executive Committee Member responsible for Transport and Infrastructure,

- i. To make budgetary provisions for equipping two village polytechnics in the County for purposes of locally assembling culverts and other associated road infrastructure items with the requisite low cost technology including but not limited to interlocking Stabilized Soil Block (ISSB) technology.
- ii. Ensure that the locally made culverts and other locally assembled road construction items, which are up to standard, are given a preference in awarding of tenders for construction of said roads in the County.
- iii. Ensure that substantial labor based County Public Works contracts during roads construction in the County are awarded to the local youth and other marginalized groups.
