- (v) Clearance Certificate from a Credit Reference Bureau (CRB).
- (vi) Clearance from the Ethics and Anti –Corruption Commission (EACC)
- (vii) Certified copy of the National ID / passport.
- (viii) A copy of the Curriculum Vitae (CV).

**Candidates with foreign academic certificates MUST obtain accreditation from the Commission for Higher Education of Kenya.**

Members of the public are invited to attend the public hearing and/or submit any information or comments on suitability or otherwise, for appointment of the nominated persons.
