

- vii. Make reports and recommendations to the House as often as possible, including recommendation of proposed legislation.

## **2.0 CONSIDERATION OF THE SECTOR ANNUAL WORKPLAN FOR FY 2023/2024**

### **2.1 Background Information**

**Hon.Speaker**, Devolution in Kenya constitutionally assigned 14 functions under the Schedule IV of the constitution, including agriculture, County health and Transport services, Trade and tourism development and County Planning. Article 174 of the Constitution defines one of the key objectives of devolution as the promotion of social and economic development and provision of proximate, easily accessible services throughout Kenya.

The Fourth Schedule of the Constitution of Kenya provides for the Agricultural Policy as a function of the National Government. It transfers key components of agriculture including crop and animal husbandry, fisheries development and control of plant and animal diseases amongst others to the County governments.

The Second Schedule (Standing Order 204) mandates the Sectoral Committee Agriculture,Livestok and Fisheries to deal with all matters related to agriculture, including crop and animal husbandry, livestock sale yards, county abattoirs, plant and animal disease control and fisheries, animal control and welfare, including licensing of dogs and facilities for the accommodation, care and burial of animals and veterinary services.

Upon consideration of the Annual Sector Workplan for FY 2023/2024, the Committee made the following observations;



1. **THAT**, the Fertilizer Subsidy Programme was allocated Kshs 197,960,790 in the current Financial Year however it was not captured in the Sector Annual Workplan.
2. **THAT**, there is no policy framework/guidelines developed by the Department to support implementation fertilizer Subsidy Programme and Agriculture Value Chain grant.
3. **THAT**, the implementation of the new constitution to devolved key functions means that the Fisheries sector now falls entirely under county government.

### **4.2 Committee Recommendations**

**The Committee Recommends as follows:**

1. **THAT**, the Department of Agriculture, Livestock, Veterinary Services and Fisheries should identify current challenges causing delays in implementing development projects in the Agricultural Sector and outline suitable measures to address them.
2. **THAT** the County Executive Committee Member In charge of the Department of Agriculture, Livestock, Veterinary Services and Fisheries should in future ensure proper dissemination of information regarding programmes that require the participation of members of public so that the deserving and interested groups are not left out from such programmes.
3. **THAT**, the Department should ensure that relevant and regular reports on the projects/programmes are submitted to the County Assembly Committee of Agriculture, Livestock and Fisheries detailing the relevance of the project/programs, level of achievement of the projects/programmes, impact and sustainability among other items.
4. **THAT**, the County Executive Committee Member for Agriculture, Livestock and Fisheries should submit to the County Assembly policy documents on the Fertilizer Subsidy and the Livestock Value Chain grant under the agriculture sector.
5. **THAT**, the County Department in charge of Agriculture, Livestock, Veterinary Services and Fisheries should allocate funds in the Fisheries subsector and enact legislation and policies geared towards revamping the Subsector
